

Poster Presentation Instructions

You will be graded on the posters your created (50pts) & your presentation of the posters(50pts)

Poster Requirements:

1. Minimum of 5 posters are required (not including title & works cited posters)
2. Presentation format should follow same format as your paper
3. Short, precise statements of the information should be on the posters. You are to talk about the figures from your knowledge obtained during your research and analysis. (You are not to read it off the posters)
4. You are to add one additional piece of information that is not mentioned on the posters (it could be an explanation of the image)
5. Illustrations are required on the posters. (Drawings/maps/images/pictures/graphs) You should have at least 5 on each poster.
6. Color combinations should not distract/obscure ability to see posters.
7. You may bring in artifacts to enhance your presentation.

The following two rubrics will be used to grade the poster presentations:
